Scripture:

Matthew 1:1-12, Galatians 4:4-7, John 3:16-17

Last Week:

Introduction:

What did Jesus come to redeem us from? Have you personally accepted in faith what Jesus did on the cross?

Jesus cam to give you a new identity: from a slave to sin to an adopted son or daughter. What does this mean to you personally?

According to the passage, you have received an inheritance through God. What are you an heir to?

Does knowing this change how you feel and think about yourself?
