## **Read Deuteronomy 6:4-9**

What are these verses encouraging us to do? What does it mean to love the Lord with all your heart, soul and strength? In your day to day life, how is this done?

Looking closely at verse 7, where do you see those times in your family’s rhythm? Where are you intentionally and regularly talking about the things of God with your family?

## **Apply**

Where is God moving you to lead in impressing these teachings on your children’s hearts?
