Andy shared three things that Paul prayed for the believers in Ephesus...

- Be strengthened with power (v.16)
- Christ would dwell in their hearts (v.17)
- Know (experience) the love of Christ (v.19)



What does it mean to have God’s Spirit in your “inner being”?

Does Christ “dwell” in your heart or does He just “visit”? What are the differences? (privileges, roles, etc.)

“Love” is one of those things that you need experiential knowledge to better understand it. How do you get that experience?

How would you explain the relationship between these three things?

Doing It

Want to see how this can change your life? In your group, put everyone’s name in a hat. Grab a name and pray Paul’s prayer for them each day. If you are not involved with a group, find a person that will join you.
